Over in south Liverpool, we continue our series of **Sketching in the Palm House** events at **Sefton Park Palm House** in February and April. In addition we have a 10 Week **Drawing in the Palm House** evening course also led by award winning artist Josie Jenkins. Both the one day and 10 week courses will give you the opportunity to learn or recap basic techniques to help you draw from observation, try different materials and express what you see through drawing, in unique and inspiring surroundings. New for this season we have a **Beginners Photowalk**, led by Rachel Brewster, who will guide participants in a leisurely stroll around the Palm House and its surroundings, giving tips and tricks on how to get the best from your film, digital or even smartphone camera.
