Metamorphosis: John Petch x OMD, LightNight in Queen Avenue

Join dot-art in Queen Avenue on Friday 18th May for a vibrant evening of art, music and food, part of citywide arts festival LightNight, as we launch our exhibition Metamorphosis: John Petch x OMD, with some surprise musical guests!

On Friday 18th May from 5pm until 10pm, you are invited to explore Queen Avenue to celebrate LightNight and this year's theme of "Transformation". Visitors will be able to see new art exhibition Metamorphosis: John Petch x OMD at the dot-art Gallery, which looks at the changing of one form to another, sample food and drink from a range of street food traders and listen to live music.

Metamorphosis is a new exhibition of paintings and drawings by Liverpool-born artist John Petch. In 2016, John was asked by electronic band Orchestral Manoeuvres in the Dark, who hail from Wirral, to design the cover for their new album. This collection comprises the development and preparatory work for the individual painting, the accompanying single artwork designs and subsequent pieces inspired by the creation of these now highly recognisable artworks.

The album art represents a morphing of physical states; from colour to black and white, human form to mechanical, creating tension between the known and unknown. Taking inspiration from the symbolist works of Giovanni Sagantini, whose foreboding painting 'The Punishment of Luxury' lends its name to OMD's 16th studio album, Petch translates traditional philosophy into abstract symbolism using bold geometric intersections and acidic blocks of colour.

Limited edition prints of the album art "The Punishment of Luxury", signed by both the artist and the band, will be available to buy on LightNight.

This year's <u>LightNight</u> programme explores the theme of 'Transformation', and through art, music and live performance, looks at the changes that are happening around us; the cultural vista and political agenda and importantly, reflects on the transformation of our city in the ten years since our capital of culture title.
